

Pierce Township Trustees
Meeting Minutes

Special Meeting
January 31, 2012 – 4 PM

The Board of Trustees of Pierce Township, Clermont County, Ohio met in Special Session at 4PM on Tuesday, January 31, 2012 at the Pierce Township Administration Building, 950 Locust Corner Rd. Cincinnati, Ohio 45245

Call to Order/ Roll Call

Chairman Christopher Knoop called the meeting to order at 4pm. Board members present: Mrs. Bonnie Batchler, Mr. Richard Riebel, and Mr. Christopher Knoop. Also present: David Elmer, Township Administrator. Karen Register, Fiscal Officer was not in attendance.

A **Motion** was made by Mrs. Batchler, seconded by Mr. Riebel, to appoint Administrator Elmer as acting Clerk. Roll call: All aye. The motion passed on unanimous vote.

Mr. Elmer presented to the Board Resolution #012-006, a Resolution authorizing the Township administrator to apply for Ohio Department of Natural Resource Recreational Trails Program and Clean Ohio Trails Program Grant funds. Mr. Elmer apprized the Board that the Grant application must be postmarked by tomorrow. Mr. Elmer reviewed the proposed grant noting the costs and obligations of the Township. Mr. Elmer noted that the trail would start at the intersection of Behymer Rd. and Locust Corner Rd. and run eastward to a termination point at the Legendary Run Golf Course Maintenance Shop (directly across from Legendary Trails Dr.) Mr. Elmer noted that easements were obtained from the Golf Course and the Legendary Run Home Owners Association for lands extending further east past the Maintenance Shop to the intersection of Locust Corner Rd. and Merwin-Ten Mile Rd; however, the Township would not be applying for grant funds for the additional segment because the costs associated with constructing the additional section were prohibitive.

Betty Council, a township resident, expressed her concerns to the Board about the costs and purposes associated with the project

A **Motion** to adopt Resolution #012-006 was made by Mr. Riebel, seconded by Mrs. Batchler. Roll call: All aye. The motion passed on unanimous vote.
