

Pierce Township Trustees
Meeting
Minutes

March 1, 2013 3:00 PM

The Board of Trustees of Pierce Township, Clermont County, Ohio met in Special Session at 3:00 PM, on Friday, March 1, 2013 at the Pierce Township Administration Building, 950 Locust Corner Road.

CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairman Rich Riebel called the meeting to order. Board members answering roll call: Mr. Rich Riebel, Bonnie Batchler, and Mr. Chris Knoop. Also, present were Claudia Carroll, Assistant to the Township Administrator, Tim Hershner, Assistant Township Administrator for Planning, Zoning and Community Development and Township Administrator Dave Elmer.

Claudia Carroll Appointed Acting Clerk

Mrs. Batchler made a motion, seconded by Mr. Knoop to appointed Claudia Carroll as Acting Clerk. Roll call on the motion: All aye.

Tim Hershner Leads Discussion

Tim Hershner began by mentioning the good development prospects along SR 52 corridor, with possible marina and residential units, Dave Elmer provided an update on Sky Valley, and then the discussion continued regarding other possible developments.

Mr. Riebel reminded the audience that this was a work session and that comments will be limited to committee members until the end of the meeting. Both Stan Shadwell and Pete Kay provided updates, with Pete pledging to follow up with Duke Energy.

013-004 – Resolution - County Road Resurfacing

Mr. Knoop made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Batchler to approve and adopt Resolution 013-004 which is an agreement for repaving whereby the County will undertake the public bidding procedure to obtain bids for such improvement and/or repair and resurfacing in accordance with the statutory requirements for such acquisition of public improvements by the Township in order to obtain more favorable pricing for said road repairs. Roll call on motion: All aye. See attached Resolution 013-004.

Discussion from the Audience

A group of township residents asked the Board about the NOPE agreement and after fielding numerous questions, Mr. Riebel the residents that the Board is not intending to do anything without first including the NOPE group.
