Subject: Green Space Minutes 12/2/15

The following are minutes to the Green Space Meeting on 12/2/15

Attendees: Sherrill Callahan, Pat Hogan, George Carpenter, Tim Hershner, Nancy Ball, Bob Pautke, Doug Dresie

1. Discussed organization and incorporation of Parks into the Greenspace Resolution. Reviewed original resolution. Tim to e-mail committee members regarding grouping/revising the original resolution to incorporate parks. Doug is to work on a draft resolution.
2. Reviewed Master Plan progress.
 - a. The group decided to target June 1, 2016 to complete the master plan.
 - b. If private septic system used for park restrooms, cost range would be \$30-40K.
 - c. Discussed locations of potential elements such as restroom, shelter house, potential stage, berm along Locust Corner for safety, etc.
 - d. We will target the February meeting to invite the local David Williams Associates representative. They will be a good resource for park improvements.
3. Discussed recruiting additional volunteers subcommittees. George will present Master Plan progress at Trustee Meeting on 12/9/15. Also discussed reaching out to the community through Facebook to update progress with contact for planning help. It may also be a good idea to put out on CERKL.
4. Pat stated that his Boy Scout group has mentioned volunteering to clear existing overgrown trails at the park in the wooded area behind the playground. This would be a great project to get started in the spring.
5. Pat has started developing ideas for trail signage improvement. He is looking at developing signs with QR codes for tree identification at the Nature Trail.
6. Discussed Duke property where clay is being removed. Tim stated that it is around 100 acres and potential turnover date is in September 2016. There have been no commitments on what the status of the property will be when it is turned over as much depends on how it will be left. Tim will bring the mining plan to the next Greenspace meeting in January.
7. The first Clermont Parks Alliance Meeting has been scheduled for December 16. Doug Dresie and Nancy Ball will be attending. The Cardinal Land Conservancy has been formed officially and is moving forward. They are looking for interested parties. Doug mentioned that it appeared Clarence had been contacted. It doesn't appear any meetings have been scheduled yet.
