RESOLUTION No. 017-022

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE PIERCE TOWNSHIP POLICE, ADMINISTRATION, AND SERVICE DEPARTMENT SURPLUS AND NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC PURPOSE OR OBSOLETE, OR UNFIT FOR THE USE WHICH THE PROPERTY WAS ACQUIRED, AND APPROVING THE SALE OF THIS PROPERTY BY INTERNET-BASED AUCTION.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.10 provides that when a township has property, including motor vehicles, road machinery, equipment, and tools, and the Board, by resolution, finds is not needed for public use, or is obsolete or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired, the Board may sell and convey that property or otherwise dispose of it as surplus in accordance with this Section of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Pierce Township Board of Trustees, by Resolution 017-015, has determined that it would be appropriate to sell such property by internet auction as provided in R.C. 505.10(D); and

WHEREAS, the Township by and through its Police, Administration, and Service Department owns personal property that is not needed, or is unfit for the use for which such property was acquired, or is obsolete, to wit: one (1) 2004 Ford Crown Victoria Police Cruiser; one (1) 1999 Ford Contour motor vehicle; two (2) 2013 JD Mowers; one (1) 2004 Exmark Lawn Mower; one (1) Barracuda Network – Security & Data Protection; seven (7) keyboards; one (1) Lexmark Printers Model 4530; one (1) Lexmark Printers Model 4550 one (1) 19 inch Dell Monitor; one (1) 15 inch HP Monitor; one (1) Brother Intellifax 4100e Fax Machine; one (1) HP Photosmart Printer; and one (1) HP Photosmart 5514 Printer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Pierce Township, Clermont County, Ohio that:

Section 1. That the Board of Trustees of Pierce Township does hereby find and determine in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 505.10 that the following personal property is not needed, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired or obsolete, and as surplus is hereby authorized to be sold by public internet auction and in accordance with the following minimum bids, to wit: one (1) 2004 Ford Crown Victoria Police Cruiser with a starting bid of \$500.00; one (1) 1999 Ford Contour motor vehicle with a starting bid of \$500.00; two (2) 2013 JD Mowers with a starting bid of \$5,000.00 for each; one (1) 2004 Exmark Lawn Mower with a starting bid of \$250.00; one (1) Barracuda Network – Security & Data Protection with a starting bid of \$200.00; seven (7) keyboards with a starting bid of \$25.00 for each; one (1) Lexmark Printer Model 4530 with a starting bid of \$10.00; one (1) Lexmark Printer Model 4550 with a starting bid of \$10.00; one (1) 19 inch Dell Monitor with a starting bid of \$5.00; one (1) 15 inch HP Monitor with a starting bid \$5.00; one (1) Brother Intellifax 4100e Fax Machine with a starting bid \$15.00; one (1) HP Photosmart Printer with a starting bid of \$15.00; and one (1) HP Photosmart 5514 Printer with a starting bid of \$15.00; ten (10) Getac Laptops with a starting bid of \$50 each.

Section 2. That such personal property shall be offered for sale by public internet auction and in accordance with Section 505.10(D) of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. The Township Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to advertise the above auction at least two weeks in advance, plus provide notice on the Township website. The notice shall give the above details of the auction plus clear instructions how access to the website may be achieved, and how to find the auction items on the website, and the terms of sale, including the provision for timing of payment and the pickup and delivery of such items.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Pierce Township concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board of Trustees Pierce Township and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in those formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Board of Trustees and as further provided under Ohio law.
