

Pierce Township Trustees
Special Meeting Minutes
January 4, 2022

The Board of Trustees of Pierce Township, Clermont County, Ohio met for a Special Meeting at 4:00p.m., Tuesday, January 4, 2022 at the Pierce Township Administration Building, 950 Locust Corner Road.

CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Allen Freeman called the meeting to order. Trustee Kambelos, Trustee Nicholas Kelly, and Chairman Allen Freeman were present at roll call. Attorney Tom Keating, Planning & Zoning Administrator Eddie McCarthy, Police Chief Jeff Bachman, Service Department Director John Koehler and Fiscal Officer Debbie Schwey were also present.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Fiscal Officer Schwey requests a motion to approve the annual salary increase of 8.2% for the Assistant to the Fiscal Office according to the increase in job duties, payroll increases,

federal regulations regarding the Cares Act and the ARP, insurances. Trustee Kelly made the motion to approve, seconded by Trustee Kambelos. Roll call: All aye.
