	Park Improvements
1.1	<ul> <li>Groh Park and Locust Corner Park Projects Update:</li> <li>All Committee members agreed with the alternative playground equipment being provided by the contractor for Groh Park. It is the same as the committee previously reviewed. Doug will confirm to Kleingers in an e-mail.</li> <li>Tim advised that the contractor had provided a schedule, but, it could use more detail.</li> </ul>
1.2	Pickle Ball Follow Up: The resurfacing and striping was discussed in the Trustee's Meeting in October. It is currently being tabled until further pricing and review. The Township needs to also consider other pressing facility needs.
1.3	Futsal Follow Up: There was no further information regarding Futsal in the meeting.

2.1	<ul> <li>Christmas Tree Lighting, Thursday, 12/15/22, from 7pm-8pm:</li> <li>Dan Newyear has lined up an competitive acapella group as well as an instrumental group from West Clermont High School. The event is scheduled for one hour. Dan will firm up plans around Thanksgiving.</li> <li>Anne will e-mail Bixby Coffee about providing hot chocolate.</li> <li>Michelle recommends biodegradable ornaments for the tree. Potentially wooden ornaments or make them with pine cones. These could be rolled in peanut butter with birdseed rather than glue and glitter. We will have some of the volunteers gather pine cones at the clean-up day.</li> <li>Doug will send Craig Wright about the use of the speaker and microphone for the event.</li> </ul>
2.1	Concert in the Park 2023: Michelle will contact Leroy Ellington after the first of the year to discuss band options.
2.2	<ul> <li>Movie in the Park 2023:</li> <li>Dan has been in touch with Fever Flicks for movie screen and equipment. They perform set up and take down. The screens they recommend are 24' or 26' wide with rear projection. The size of the screen is to tall to put up on the Learning Center stage. Swank is the licensing company we would need to go through for the movie. February is the appropriate time frame to work on scheduling.</li> <li>Pat will also check with some other rental companies.</li> <li>Dan checked with Pierce Point Theatre, and we can purchase bags of pre-made popcorn from them.</li> </ul>

Doug mentioned that we may need to review Groh Park as a resident had e-mailed the Township about potential needs along the creek bed. Doug will review.
