4.5	<ul> <li>Pierce Preserve &amp; Trails: Don Kelley provided the following updates.</li> <li>NOPE has agreed to spend \$25k - \$30k to have some grading, tree planting, and wildflower planting performed at the preserve. This will also include a flagstone paved area for drop off, message board, etc.</li> <li>Don Kelley and Allen Freeman are working with Congressman Doug Green on a grant opportunity for invasives removal and further trail development in partnership with the Cincinnati Nature Center.</li> </ul>
